

Renewing and/or Transferring a Harris County Stormwater Quality Permit

Consulting Engineer or Property Owner:

ALL SWQ permit renewals / transfers must be submitted through the ePermits online system (https://apps.harriscountytx.gov/EPermits/Login.aspx).

In order to Renew or Transfer a Stormwater Quality Permit, the following items will be required:

Permit Renewal

- 1. Permits must be renewed annually on or before the anniversary date of the Certificate of Compliance issued for the SWQ permit. If the permit is renewed on time the renewal fee is \$250. If the permit expires the fee is \$500. If the permit has been expired for multiple years, each year's expired fee will be added to the renewal fee. Payment for the renewal and/or transfer will be made through the ePermits online payment system using a debit/credit card.
- A completed, signed, and sealed *Annual P.E. Inspection Certification* Form and a completed and notarized *Annual Permittee Certification Form* are required.

Permit Transfer

- 1. If the property has changed ownership then the permit must be transferred to the new owner. A SWQ Transfer Application submitted through ePermits listing the new owner as the Property Owner is required. The transfer will result in a new SWQ permit being issued. It will have a new permit number, but the renewal date will remain the same (see above #1).
- 2. The transfer fee to a private entity is \$300. Payment for the transfer will be made through the ePermits online payment system using a debit/credit card.
- An initial transfer to a Municipal Utility District does not require a fee. However, a letter from the MUD, accepting responsibility for maintenance and operation of the Storm Water Quality Management Plan and feature(s) are necessary. If the permit applicant is a corporation, partnership or other legal entity other than a natural person, then the undersigned acting as the authorized representative of said entity will be responsible for ensuring the entity's compliance with all provisions, conditions and requirements of the Stormwater Quality Permit.
